



## Equipment List

### All Hunters:

- Tag
- Weapon
- Ammo (40 rounds preferably- you may need them if the scope gets bumped off and need to re sight you weapon, in the field I usually carry 10 rounds on my person and 10 in my pack. The extra box can stay in camp if needed.)
- Optics (8X Binos work for most all hunting I use a 10X42 Bino),
- Glass wipes
- 1 Change of clothes
- Sleeping Bag
- Personal Hygiene & articles
- Adequate Mountain-Meat Packing Hunting Pack/Day pack for Horseback Elk/Deer Hunters
- 2 water bottles 1L each (Filled)
- Sunglasses
- Lip Balm
- Sunscreen
- 1 Knife
- Lighter-No butane lighters, these do not work at higher altitudes
- Space Blanket
- Small first aid kit
- Aspirin
- Whistle
- Compass
- Hat for hot and cold conditions
- Gloves, leather and Cold weather waterproof
- 2 Flashlights w extra batteries – LED head lamp are great to use in the woods.
- Camera
- Gators
- Rain Poncho – Army Ponchos are the best.
- Hunting boots and a Boot suitable for snow travel



- Bandana
- Balaclava
- Elk and Deer Rifle Hunters 500sq in of Solid Daylight Florescent Orange, Vest and Hat, + Vest or blaze fabric to go over your backpack when worn.
- Game Bags Extra if you have room
  
- (Optional)
  - Range Finder
  - Camp Shoes
  - Rubber gloves – for working with downed animals
  - Trash bag to line you backpack and gear.
  - 1gal Zip Lock Bags to store your gear in your backpack.
  - Ear plugs for windy nights, noisy horses, and guides.
  - Hand warmers
